# **Engaging Learners with Google Literature Trips**

### **Description:**

Engage students with integrated visual learning using Google Earth to develop the geographic story/timeline connecting to literature you study in class. Work together to create a Google Literature Trip you can use in your classroom in the Fall.

### Purpose:

To provide a tool set for teachers to engage students in learning Google Earth's visual geography tool.

### **Objectives:**

- Expose teachers to tools that will engage students in literature, introduce geography concepts, activate background knowledge, and provide your students access and exposure to the world around them?
- This session will explain how to create a Google Literature Trip and how to make cross-curricular connections. We will explore the basics of Google Earth such as navigation toolbar, measurement tools, featured content, placemarks, and layers of information.

It is also possible while building a Google
 Lit Trip with a class to address National
 Geographic's Five Themes of Geography. We will follow the

author of two Google Literature Trips and the learning journey of the creation process.
